MEASURE	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED
B.A. Graduation Rate	The rate reflects the percentage of students who started the program in the 2017-2018 year and completed in 6 years or less. The group includes 1st year, transfer students, and students in the non-traditional program who declared their major within the 2017-2018 year. Students who switched majors but graduated from Chaminade count against this rate, as do students who did not graduate from Chaminade.
B.S. Graduation Rate	The rate reflects the percentage of students who started the program in the 2017-2018 year and completed in 6 years or less. The group includes 1st year and transfer students who declared their major within the 2017-2018 year. Students who switched majors but graduated from Chaminade count against this rate, as do students who did not graduate from Chaminade.

MBA Graduation Rate	The rate for each MBA program reflects the percentage of students who started the program in the 2018-2019 year and completed in 4 years or less. The rate does not account for students who switched concentrations. For example, if a student was declared with an Accounting concentration and switched to and graduated as a general MBA, that counts against the Accounting MBA graduation rate but not for the General MBA.
* Target Bachelor Graduation Rate	The target rate is a comparison of the business degree rate with the University's bachelor's degree rate for the full-time first-time student cohort
**Total MBA Graduation Rate	The rate for the total MBA program reflects the percentage of all students who started the program in the 2018-2019 year and completed in 4 years or less. The rate accounts for students who switched concentrations within the degree. The University does not track cohorts for masters programs due to rolling admissions that allow for multiple start terms in an academic year. The target rate is a comparison of the total MBA rate with the University's similarly structured average graduate degree rate
