

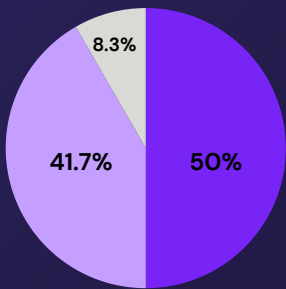

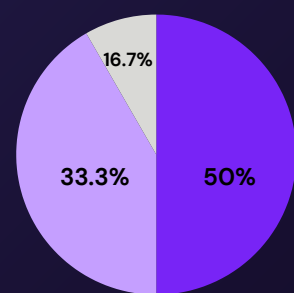
Students who felt the overall presentation on savings and investments was beneficial to their financial journeys.

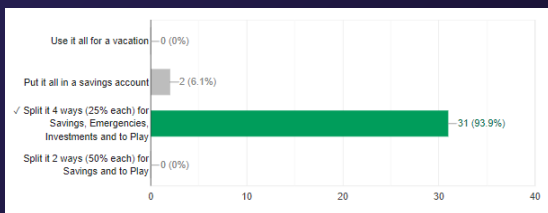

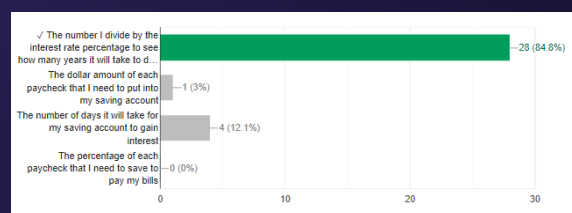
#### BUDGETING: RULE OF 4THS

After you calculate your expenses for the month, what was recommended you do with the remaining money you have from your paycheck?



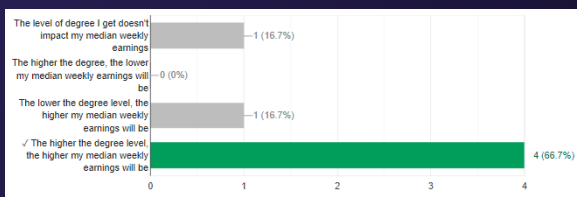
#### INVESTMENTS: RULE OF 72

What is the Rule of 72?



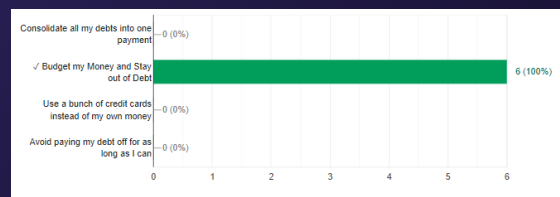
#### PAYING FOR COLLEGE
